Summary of Information

- Based on information provided at Information Seminar at Sydney Police Centre on 31st July 2007
- Police expect approx 10,000 protesters in Sydney CBD split into 3 groups
 - “Mum & Dad” Protesters
 - Issue Motivated Groups (IMGs)
 - Anarchists
- Potential for increased number of hoax threat & nuisance calls during APEC period
- Business disruption or office invasion risk for global / Australian icon organisations

Suggested Actions 1

- Briefing on security and emergency procedures for all staff who must be present in CBD during APEC period, including reception staff, cleaners, temp staff
- Increase security measures in public accessible areas / access points
- Restrict access to floors via lifts and stairs
- Train appropriate personnel in White Level search techniques
- Remove moveable objects from foyers / lobbies / loading docks – anything that can be picked up & thrown, bins, planters, sculptures etc

Suggested Actions 2

- Secure access to unused areas with cable ties
- Check CCTV cameras daily, and fire doors every 3 hours for signs of tampering
- Cancel meetings with external visitors / reduce number of visitors to premises during APEC period
