16:05	17:00	Keynote Speaker - Mark Prentice "Business Continuity Maturity Model (BCMM)" An international group of professionals established the BCMM during the early 2000's. This was released in 2003. Rather than assessing the individual, the BCMM assesses the maturity of the Program within an organization against a common set of criteria. This has been aligned with the British Standard and various American Standards and regulations. One of the strengths of this approach is the ability to benchmark an organization against similar organizations in the same industry. Another strength when used within the same organization to measure the change in maturity over time. The presentation will give an overview of the BCMM including both the publically available and the proprietary versions.
